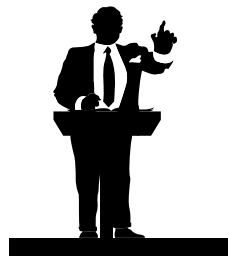

Membership Categories

LLSSA/ESA Regular Member, & Multi— Branch - For companies with a single office, dues are based on total number of employees in the company. Employees are defined as full time employees, including office, sales and administrative personnel engaged in any way with the alarm operations of the company. Members are allowed one vote.

LLSSA/ESA National Company - For companies with two or more branches in 15 states. Members are allowed one vote. \$440 annually.

LLSSA Associate Membership - For business entities that are engaged in manufacturing, distributing, supplying, dealing in or selling products or services generally used and relating to and necessary to the Regular Members. Members are allowed one vote. \$150 annually.

LLSSA Affiliate Membership - For business entities that do not otherwise qualify for membership under any other membership category, but have capability of contributing significant value or expertise to the electronic security industry or provide design, installation, service or monitoring of electronic security systems for its own and not either the general public or to alarm dealers. This is non-voting membership. \$150 annually.

LLSSA Related Industry Membership - For business entities engaged in providing to the public design, installation or servicing of systems or devices that are related to the security or fire alarm industry. Members are allowed one vote. \$340 annually.

LLSSA Public Safety Membership - For police or fire department of any governmental organization or any governmental agency concerned with law enforcement of fire safety. This is a non-voting membership. \$50 annually.

LLSSA Alumni Membership—Conferred by the LLSSA and NBFSA Board of Directors on an individual who wishes to continue membership, but who is no longer associated with the electronic security industry. To qualify, an individual must have previously served as a designated representative of a Regular Member. This is a non-voting membership. \$100 annually.
